An On-Call Service 6 pm-2 am

The Lift offers free on-call service between all designated Lift stops to ensure you have a safe and reliable ride home from work and play. To schedule a pick-up: Call 970.726.4163

ADA ACCESSIBILITY

All buses are accessible to persons with disabilities. Ramps are located at the front doors. The Lift offers priority seating and wheelchair securement areas. All stops are announced to ensure that information is accessible to everyone. Passengers using wheelchairs or scooters have priority to the flip-seat wheelchair securement areas. Seniors and passengers with disabilities have priority to the Lift's fixed priority seats.

PARATRANSIT/FREE DOOR-TO-DOOR SERVICE

7 pm-2 am, 7 days a week

Free paratransit service is available for all ADA eligible riders. This is a door-to-door service that will pick you up and drop you off anywhere in the Winter Park, Fraser, or MeadowRidge areas, anytime during regular service hours. To schedule a ride, call: 970.726.4163 or visit TheLiftWP.com

COVID-19

The safety of our riders, employees and community is a top priority for The Lift. We are closely monitoring the Coronavirus COVID-19 situation and following the guidance of health experts from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and Colorado Department of Health and Environment (CDPHE).
